



**Universidad Adventista de las Antillas**

**Quarterly Budget and Expenditure Reporting under HEERF I, II, III- Student Portion**

**July-September 2021**

*October 8, 2021*

Universidad Adventista de las Antillas (UAA) received an allocation of funding for direct student support from the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund III (HEERF III) which is authorized by the American Rescue Plan (ARP). HEERF III financial aid grants to students may be used for any portion of their cost of attendance, and/or for emergency expenses due to COVID-19 such as: tuition, housing, food, transportation health care, mental health care, and child care.

Universidad Adventista de las Antillas received a total of \$6,159,576.00 from the Department of Education under ARP. The total amount of funds that UAA received for distribution of emergency financial aid grants to students was \$ 3,085,258.00. A remaining of \$49,638.00 of HEERF II were added to HEERF III available funds.

As of September 30, 2021 a total of **935** students were awarded ARP Grants for a total of **\$1,580,850.00**

**HEERF III Application (Round 1)**

To be eligible students must:

- Be enrolled for fall 2021 semester/trimester as of August 27, 2021
- Priority given to students who are identified as having exceptional need.

Eligibility parameters were established based upon several factors, including stipulations in the federal ARP, federal law, U.S. Department of Education guidelines and internal financial aid procedures. Universidad Adventista de las Antillas (UAA) used criteria to develop a plan for assisting as many UAA students as possible.

For Phase 1 of HEERF III, all eligible students were notified via email and text at the end of August, 2021 of the amounts to be posted to their E-Cams and the amounts were posted by the end of September. All students were given the option to request the funds through direct deposit or by checks. The remaining funds for HEERF III Student Aid will be distributed on February, 2022.
